



# Starlight Toddler Skirt

This is a darling Skirt. It is mean to be worn over black leggings. This is a medium skill level. This Skirt Fits a 2-3T girl. It has hip size of 22" and waist of 20". Can't pass on this one!

Materials: 2 Skeins - Spa Yarn: Natural, ½" waist band about 20" long, Darning needle.

SL = Slip Stitch

CH = Chain

SC = Single Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

TR = Treble Crochet

CC = Crazy Cluster: TR In st , but leaving 2 loops on hook, DC around TR and complete stitch, CH 1, TR around 1<sup>st</sup> TR again leaving 2 loops on hook, DC around just made TR and complete the st.

Waist band:

Base: Ch 108, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> CH made, CH 1, turn.

Rnd 1-9: SC around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, Ch 1 turn.

Ribbon holes:

Rnd 10: 1 SC, Ch 2, Sk 1 sp, 104 SC, Ch 2, Sk 1 sp, 1 SC, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, Ch 1, turn.

Body of Skirt:

Rnd 11: 2 SC, 1 SC in CH 2 sp, SC around to next CH 2 sp, 1 SC | Ch 2 sp, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, CH 1, turn.

Rnd 12: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 13: 3 SC, \*CH 1, Sk 4 sps, in next sp (CC, CH 2, CC), Ch 1, Sk 4 sps, 1 SC, Sk 1 sp, CH 1, 1 SC, CH 1, SK 4 sps, In next sp ( CC, CH 2, CC), Ch 1, SK 4 sps, 3 SC, Rep from \* around. On last Rep 4 SC instead of 3 SC, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC, CH 2, turn.

Rnd 14: \*2 DC, 2 DC in next sp, Ch 4, Sk (SC, Ch 1, CC), 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, CH 4, SK (CC, CH 1, SC), In CH 1 sp (DC, CH 1, DC), CH 4, Sk (SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in CH 2 sp, CH 4, Sk (CC, CH 1, SC), 2 DC in next sp, Rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> DC made, CH 4, turn.

Rnd 15: \* CC in DC, CH 1, Sk DC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, CH 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk DC, In Ch1 sp (CC, Ch 2, CC), Ch 1, SC in Ch 4 sp, CH 1, SK SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, SK DC, In DC sp ( CC, TR), 2 DC, Rep from \* around, Last rep 1 DC instead of 2 DC, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> TR, Ch 1, turn.

Rnd 16: \* 3 SC, CH 4, Sk (CC, Ch 1, SC), In Ch 1 sp ( DC, Ch 1, DC), CH 4, Sk (SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, CH 4, SK (CC, CH 1, SC), In Ch 1 sp ( DC, CH 1, DC), CH 4, Sk (SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in TR sp, Rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, CH 1 turn.

Rnd 17: \*2 SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, CH 1, Sk DC, In CH 1 sp ( CC, Ch 2, CC), Ch 1, Sk DC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, Ch 1, SK SC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, SK DC, In CH 1 sp (CC, CH 2, CC), Ch 1, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, 2 SC, Rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, Ch 2 turn.

Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 14

Rnd 19: \* CC in DC, Ch 1, Sk DC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk DC, In CH 1 sp (CC, CH 2, CC), CH 1, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, CH 1, SK SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, SK DC, In DC sp ( CC, TR), 1 DC, 2 DC in next, Rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> TR, CH 1, turn.

Rnd 20: 1 SC, \*1 SC, 2 SC in next sp, 2 SC, Ch 4, Sk ( CC, Ch 1, SC), In CH 1 sp ( DC, CH 1, SC), CH 4, Sk (SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in CH 2 sp, Ch 4, SK (CC, CH 1, SC), In Ch 1 sp (DC, CH 1, DC), CH 4, SK (SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in TR, Rep from \* around to last Rep, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC instead of 1 SC in TR, CH 1, turn.

Rnd 21: \* 1 SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, CH 1, SK DC, in CH 1 sp ( CC, CH 2, CC), CH 1, Sk DC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, SK DC, in Ch 1 sp ( CC, CH 2, CC), Ch 1, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, 2 SC, 2 SC in next, 2 SC in next, 1 SC, Rep from \* around SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, CH 2 turn.

Rnd 22: \* 3 DC, 2 DC in next, 3 DC, Ch 4, SK ( SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, CH 4, Sk (CC, CH 1, SC), In Ch 1 sp (DC, CH 1, DC), Ch 4, Sk (SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, CH 4, Sk ( CC, Ch 1, SC), 1 DC \* rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> DC made, Ch 4, turn.

Rnd 23: \* CC in DC, Ch 1, Sk DC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, CH 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk DC, In Ch 1 sp ( CC, CH 2 CC), CH 1, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, CH 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, SK DC, In DC sp ( CC, TR), 2 DC, 2 DC in next, 2 DC, Rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> TR, CH 1, turn.

Rnd 24: \* 8 SC, CH 4, SK (CC, Ch 1, SC), In Ch 1 sp (DC, CH 1 DC), Ch 4, Sk (SC, Ch 1, CC), 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, CH 4, Sk (CC, Ch 1, SC), In CH 1 sp ( DC, CH 1, DC), Ch 4, Sk ( SC, Ch 1, CC) 1 SC in TR sp, Rep from \* around, Last rep, No 1 SC , Just SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, Ch 1 turn.

Rnd 25: \* 1 SC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk dc, In CH 1 sp ( CC, Ch 2, CC), Ch 1, SK DC, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, Sk DC, In CH 1 sp (CC, CH 2, CC), Ch 1, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, 3 SC, 2 SC in next, 2 sc in next, 2 SC, Rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, Ch 2 turn.

Rnd 26: \* 3 DC, 3 DC in next sp, 3 DC in next sp, 3 DC, 2 DC in next, Ch 4, Sk (SC, CH 1, CC) 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, Ch 4, Sk (CC, CH 1, SC), In Ch 1 Sp ( DC, Ch 1, DC), CH 4, Sk (SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, Ch 4, Sk (CC, CH 1, SC), 2 DC in next sp, Rep from \* around, on last rep End with 1 DC in the same DC as 1<sup>st</sup>, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> DC made, Ch 4, turn.

Rnd 27: \* CC in dc, Ch 1, Sk DC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, Ch 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, CH 1, SK dc, In CH 1 sp (CC, CH 2, CC), CH 1, 1 SC in CH 4 sp, CH 1, Sk SC, 1 SC in Ch 4 sp, SK DC, In DC sp ( CC, TR), % DC, Rep from \* around, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> TR, CH 1, turn.

Rnd 28: \* 8 SC, 2 SC in next sp, 2 SC in next sp, 8 SC, Ch 4, SK (CC, CH 1, SC), In Ch 1 sp ( DC, CH 1, DC) < Ch 4, SK ( SC, CH 1, CC), 1 SC in Ch 2 sp, Ch 4, SK ( CC, CH 1, SC), In CH 1 sp ( DC, CH 1, DC), Sk ( SC, CH1, CC), Rep from \* around (1<sup>st</sup> SC on Rep should start in TR sp), SL to 1<sup>st</sup> SC made, Ch 2, turn.

Rnd 29: \* In CH 4 sp ( 4 DC), 1 DC , 1 DC in CH 1 sp, 1 DC, In Ch 4 sp (4 DC), 1 DC, In Ch 4 sp ( 4 DC), 1 DC, In Ch 1 sp (1 DC), 1 DC, In Ch 4 sp ( 4 DC), 6 DC, 2 TR, 2 TR in next 4 sps, 2 TR, 6 DC, Rep from \* around, on last rep end with 5 DC instead of 6 DC, SL to 1<sup>st</sup> DC made, Ch 5, turn.

Rnd 30: \* 1 SL, Ch 5, Rep from \* around. End with SL. Tie of and hide string.

Take waist band and fold down and take a darning needle and sew Rnd 1 to rnd 10. Leave a 2 inch hole open.

Take ½" wide and 20" long waist band and run inside the waist of the skirt. Sew the two end of the Waist band together and finish sewing up Rnd 1 to Rnd 12.

The two holes made in Rnd 10 are for the black ribbon to go through. Tie a bow and Sew down if you would like or leave it loose to change colors to match different outfits; the Bow is to be worn in the back.
